

## YWCA forms group to focus on racism discussion

YWCA Lancaster will discuss "Facing Racism in a Diverse Nation" from 1 to 3 p.m. on Thursdays Oct. 7 to Nov. 11.

The study circle group will be held at YWCA, 110 N. Lime St.

The study circle will be made up of eight to 12 people from different backgrounds and viewpoints who meet six times to explore concerns about racism and look for ways to make things better. Participants try to understand each other's views but do not have to agree.

A trained facilitator will help the group focus on different aspects of the issue and ensure that all voices are heard and options explored.
