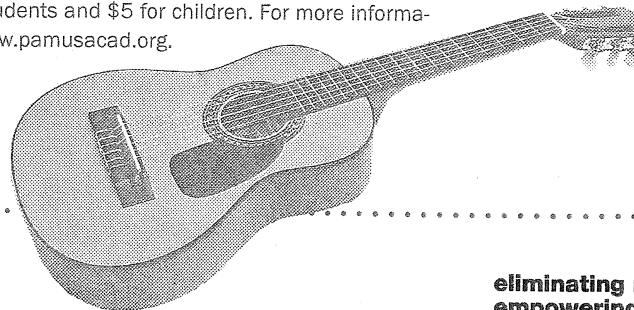




URBAN ROOTS..... TUESDAY
