YW hosts series 'Facing Racism'

A six-week discussion focusing on "Facing Racism in a Diverse Nation" will be hosted from 1 to 3 p.m. beginning April 30 at the YWCA of Lancaster, 110 N. Lime St.

Participants will be organized as a study circle of 8 to 12 people from different backgrounds and viewpoints. In a study circle, people try to understand other points of view but they do not have to agree. The idea is to explore concerns and look for ways to make things better.

There is no cost to participate.

A trained facilitator helps the group focus on different aspects of the issue and ensures all voices are heard and options are explored.
